1677 Oct 5 John Alexander, Gent. - heirs: John who died w/o issue, Robert and Phillip; Elizabeth Holmes 200 acs. where John Coggins now lives; John Dry 500 acs. "being the northernmost part of the 6750 acs on freshes of Potomac river"; **sons Robert & Philip** the rest of his estate .(Court of Stafford Co.).
