1718 Jan 15 - Survey for Richard Andrews, "**Taylor's Kindness**", 100ac. no. side Hunting Creek that issues out of north side of Great Choptank River; patent perfected Sep 10, 1723 [MD Settlers 1701-1730 by Coldham, pg. 3)
1742 June 8 - Richard Andrew, Jr. to Richard Dawson, 50 ac. from 150 acs. of "Hobston's Choice" n/w fork Nanticoke River, Dorchester Co., MD
1744 **Nov 12** - Richard Andrews, wife Mary, & John Andrews, to Thos. Canner, Jr., 100 acs. "Lankershire" on a branch of the northwest fork of the Nanticoke River [Dor. Co., MD Land Records, Lib 13, Old 8]
1762 April 6 - Nehemiah Andrew (son, Richard Andrew, Sr.) part of Pond Ridge, 40 ac. [Dor. Co., MD - 8, Old 179]
1764 May 22 - Lambert Flowers from Richard Andrew, 13 3/4 acs "**Taylor's Kindness**" [Dor. Co., MD]
1765 May 11 - Jas Murray from Lambert Flowers & Rebecca, et al, 13 3/4 acs. (Dor. Co., MD Rent Rolls, 1707-1723)
1770 - Richard Andrew 96 acs. "Addition to Pond Ridge" near "**Taylor's Kindness**" (1st surveyed for him in 1765)
