Spring branch & on north sd. Flat Swamp.] (Martin Co., NC Wills 284)] m. **Elizabeth** (MNU) ISSUE

Notes for Adam & George Coburn/Cockburn:

1718 (Bertie Deed Book#1:45) **Adam Cockburn** is joint plaintiff for debt agst. Thos. Crank, Chowan Co. Court.

1720, Aug 10, **Geo. Cockburne**, 440 acs. s/s Cassia(Cashie) River, n/sd Rocquis Swamp, a pocosin (Chowan Co., Bk 3, pg. 21)

1721-22 - Wm Smith & wife, Ann...to Richard Abel, 300 acs beg. at **Adam Cockburne's corner...Test. Geo. Cockburn** Chowan Co., Book C, No. 1 - abstracts. See Ref. #5, below.

1721 Adam Coburn, wife Dorothy Halsey & dau., Susanna, resided in Edenton, Chowan Co., NC. They were from Edinburgh, Scotland(Ref.#5 below) . Adam, Collector for Majesty, d. abt. 1729 in VA after dispute w/NC Gov.

1722, July - Gen'l Court held at Edenton Courthouse - New Commission: **Adam Cockburn**, et al

1723, Aug 29 - Jno. Arthur to **Adam Cockburn**, trust for heir of Dan'l Halsey, dec'd., 100 acs. on Bridge Branch

1724 NC Governor's Council, Chowan Co. (genweb) **Adam Cockburn**, Esqr. Asst. to Chief Justice; also a note from prior Council re disputed land lying between **George Cockburne** & Jno Williams.

1744 Sep 3 - **George Cockburn**, Bertee Co., NC, 299 acs. no. sd. Flat Swamp, from Robt. Anderson, Tyrell Co., NC

1754 - Dorothy Cockburn, wife of Adam, appointed atty. for daughter, Susanna (Chowan Co., NC) See Ref #5 below.

1761 Jan 22 - **George Cockburn**, planter, Tyrell Co., 678 acs, Parish St. Andrews, Martin Co., NC adj. Jno. Holland

Did they have dau., Lydia, not named in the will??) [July 1813 Will HEIRS: ...**wife Lydia** Coburn lands & plantation w/improvements & son Daniel Coburn gets land & plantation upon her death; daus. Martha Page, Lydia Ross, Elazor & Nancy Cobb; sons **Headley**, Azariah, Elijah; granddaughter Charlotte Coburn." Anson Co., NC] ISSUE:
