Covey farm, just off the Mooresville Pike, east of Culleoka, and they are buried in Pleasant Garden Cemetery.

5. Gift Deed, 1830/Covey, Wm. Sr.- Maury Co., Tenn., Book 0, p. 507, Tenn. State Archives Named are son, Leven L. Covey; grandson, Alfred Fleming; daughter, Sally Fleming
6. Cemetery, 1839/Covey, Wm. & Rebeckah; Maury Co., Tenn. , State Archives for Pleasant Garden Cemetery - On Covey Hollow Road from McCains to Mooresville Pike. Sign on gate reads "Pleasant Garden Cemetery, 1824". Believe this to be site of earliest Methodist Church in that area, for which land was conveyed by William Covey. Buried there: Covey, Rebeckah, consort of Wm. Covey, died 18 Oct., 1833, aged 93 yrs.; and Covey, William, d. 14 Feb, 1839, aged 91 yrs.
