Robert de Den (Dene), pincerna, butler, or sewer, to King Edward the Confessor (held estates in Sussex, Kent & Normandy. "Vide Dorset MSS., Collin's Peerage, & Harris' "Kent"; marr. UNK; ISSUE: 1. **William**

Generation 2

Robert de Dene, marr. Unk de Gatton; ISSUE: 1. **Ralph**

Generation 3

Ralph de Dene, by William the Conqueror, Lord of Buckhurst in Sussex; marr. Unk; ISSUE: 1. **Robert**

Generation 4

Robert de Dene of Sybylla, Kent, Eng.; marr. Unk; ISSUE; 1. **William**

Generation 5

William de Denne, of Denne (Parish of Kingston) co. Kent (lived during the reign of King John (1199-1216); marr. Unk; ISSUE: 1. **Sir Alured Denne**

Generation 6

Sir Alured Denne of Denne, Knight, Seneschal of the Priory of Christ Church, Canterbury, & Escheator of County of Kent, 19 Henry III (1234). Illustrious for his learning. Appointed by Henry III with Sir Henry de Bath to form the important laws of Romney Marsh. He at this early period sealed with three leopard's heads; marr. Unk; ISSUE: 1. **Walter**

Generation 7

Walter Denne of Denne, son & heir Sir Alured Denne (per charter dated 41 Henry III (1256); marr. Unk; ISSUE: 1. **John**

Generation 8

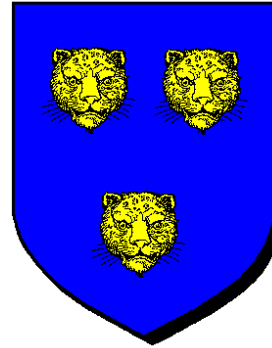
John Denne of Denne, 2 Edard II (1308); marr. Unk; ISSUE: 1. **Sir William Denne**

Generation 9

Sir William Denne of Denne, Knight, son & heir of John Denne, 2 Edward III (1328). M.P. for Canterbury 19 Edw. II & for Kent 14 Edw. III; marr. Unk; ISSUE: 1. **Richard**

Richard Denne of Denne, son & heir of Sir William Denne; marr. **Agnes Apulderfield**, (See [Apulderfield Family](#)); ISSUE: 1. Thomas 2. Michael 3. John 4. Robert (Ref: "A Genealogical & Heraldic History of the Commoners of Great Britain, Vol. 3" google ebook)

John Denne of Denne, son & heir of Thomas Denne; marr. **Alice Ardearne** (dau. Richard Ardearne); ISSUE: 1. **Michael**

Generation 13

Michael Denne of Denne, eldest son; marr. Christian Combe (dau. & heiress of ...Combe); ISSUE: **Thomas**

Generation 14

Thomas Denne of Denne, eldest son; marr. **Alice Eshhurst or Ashurst**; ISSUE: 1. William

Generation 15

William Denne of Kingston, co. Kent (2nd son); d. ca. 1572 Will proved at Doctor's Commons; marr. **Agnes Tufton** (dau. Nicholas Tufton of Northiam Place, Sussex, Esq., ancestor of the Earls of Thanet) she d. Dec. 30, 1539; ISSUE: 1. Vincent 2. Thomas 3. Mary 4. **Catherine**

Generation 16

Catherine Denne (2nd daughter); marr. Oct. 28, 1566, John Gookin (See [Gookin Family](#)).
