1761 Nov 3 John Hammond, Richmond Co., 39.25 acs. (Purchased from John Chaproe who purchased from **Charles Barber** about 50 acres); beg.g at corner of **Thomas Nash** dividing this land from **Capt. Jno Smith** land; to corner of **Thos Jasper**; to corner of **Wm Dudley**

1702 Oct 27, Richard Dudley to John Cockerill 100 acres of land by **Westmoreland Court House**; to John Follins one cow, horse etc., to James Taylor's son, William, one heifer; wife Mary Dudley residue to estate and exx. 1695 April 5, Richard Dudley, Sr. Farnham Par., Richmond Co., to Richard Jasper for 1600 lbs tob., 50 ac. so. side of Totuskey Creek, adj. Land of said Richard Jasper "to a marked beech that stands over against a branch which was formerly called Quintilian Sherman Branch". Rec 21 June 1695)

1684 April 20, Col. Richard Dudley, Gloucester Co., 281 acres on Gwins Ridge [Land Office Patents No.

7, 1679-1689 (v.1 & 2 p.1-719), p. 356 (Reel 7)] lying on Gwins Ridge in Parish of Kingstonbegining at Eastward side of Gwyn Ridge standing by or near a swamp or sunken ground near Lawson Parrote's and along by or near ye said swamp or sunken land to a corner near Lawson Perrotte's thence to first station 250 acres of aforesaid land formerly granted to aforesaid Dudley of Patent bearing date 20th of December 1667. The residue being 31 acres of land due by and for transportation of two persons into this colony.....

1684 April 20, Col. Richard Dudley, Gloucester Co., VA, 704 ac. Lying on Blackwater Creek on the eastward side of the North River [Land Office Patents No. 7, 1679-1689 (v. I and 2 p. 1-719), pg. 352 (Reel 7)]

1665, Oct. 28, Richard Dudley, Gloucester Co., VA, 944 ac. upon the branches of Poropotank Creek. Beginning at John Greens corner tree by Mr. Pates swamp. [Land Office Patents No. 6 1666-1679 (pt 1 and 2 p.1-692), pg. 172 (Reel 6)]

1665 Sep 5, William Dudley, Lancaster Co., VA 600 ac. on the north side of Peanketank opposite to the land which was formerly in the occupation of William Hockady. [Land Office Patents No. 5, 1661-1666 (v.1 & 2 p.1-369), p. 621 (Reel 5)]

1659 Sep 24, Richard Dudley, Gloucester Co., VA, Patent for 639 acres lying on the eastward side of the north river, in Mockjack Bay. Beginning at a small creeks mouth that lies within Back Waters Creeks mouth called Pine Point Creek [Land Office Patent No. 4, pag. 377]

1657 June, William Dudley, Lancaster Co., 2000 acres on the so. side of Rappahannock River, lying on the great swamp X. adjoining the land of John Howard. [Land Office Patents No. 4, 1655-1664, p. 136 (Reel 4)].

1652 Sep 20, William Dudley, 400 ac. on the western side of the north river in Mockjack Bay: beg.g at a marked tree opposite to Five Pine Island. [Land Office Patents No. 3, 1652-1655, p. 198 (Reel 2)].

1652 July 3, Richard Dudley, 200 ac. on the eastward side of the north river in Mockjack Bay: Beg.g &c. on the river side of Mr. Curtis's land, near the Black Water Creekes mouth. [Land Office Patents No. 3, 1652-1655, p. 94]
