[1714 Mar 29 (21st Feb 1716), Will of Hago/Hagan, Thomas, planter, Charles Co., MD - Heirs: To Wife Mary, extx., dwelling plantation, 300 acs. & "St. James,", also 15 acs. bought of Major Wm. Boarman; 60 acs bought of Wm. Boarman, during life, to pass at her decease to son William. to son James and hrs... 350 A., part of "Good Intent." (description see will for description) to son Ignatius and hrs., 200 A.: part of "Good Intent," also 65 acs bought of Major Wm. Boarman to son Thomas and hrs', 200 A. "Clare," adjoining "Good Intent." to dau. Mary Baggott,, 100 A., part of "Good Intent," adj. place she has already seated. to sons Thos. and Ignatius afsd., 150 A. Correcek Measure, in SMC to four. daus., Sarah Edelen., Charity Green., Anne Smith and Eliza: Clarkson,, each 10shillings. to wife afsd., entire personal estate to pass to son William at her decease. Hagan (mark); wit. Mill. Marten, Richard Edelen, Samuell Baggott, James Gaddes
