EDWARD HORNE b. abt. 1640; d. 1693 SMC, MD (1693 Estate of EDWARD HORNE, admin. William Aisquith. Heirs: Edward Horne, John Horne, Winifred Wheatley, and Henry Horne, Executor.) Marr. Winifrede (d. 1707); ISSUE:

- i. Edward, marr. Sarah Miles
- ii. John, marr. Ann Hendley
- iii. Elizabeth, marr. William Aisquith (1743 Will, Elizabeth Aisquith: son George & dau. Ann)

- v. Winifred, marr. John Wheatley

Research Log:

1664 Aug 12, Edward Horn demanded land for time of service to Thos. Hallon, Esq. and for his wife Winifred's service to Capt. Cornwallis; and 50 ac. more for transportation of Jonas bought of Capt. Miles Cook in January 1663. [Pat 7, 398]

1664 Sep 26, Edward Horne sons, 150 acs "Cole Harbor" (50 acs each) - legatees of Jno Horne

1665 June 21, "Cole Harbor" surveyed for Edward Hane[sic] Pat. Lib. 7, f. 623: land lying in woods on no. sd. of Blewstone Run NxW 120 per. to red oak then W 210 per to white oak then SxW 120 per. to gum near sd Run then E to beginning - 150 acs.

1670 April 12, Edward Horne a candidate for constable of SMC [Archives 57, p.536-7]

1670, Sep 15 Edward Horne re cattle mark of dau. Elizabeth Horne (MD Archives, 57:557)

1672, Jan 22- Edward Horne, appraiser for estate of George Goodwin [Test.Proc. 5/382]

1677 Mar 18 - Edward Horne juror re Richard Windall, shipmaster violations of trade/navigation

1681, Feb 28-Mar 30, Edward Horne, juror re tract lines in question [Archive 70, 246-53]

1682 - Survey done for Winifrede of "Maiden's Lott"

1684 - Edward Horne & Wm Aisquith sureties for estate of Abraham Reed [Test.Proc.13, 159]

1707, Rent Rolls: Edward Horn - 50 ac, 200ac & 68ac from father; 100ac from mother-in-law
