1641 June 19, James Neale demands land for transp. 5 servants: Wm. King.... [Pat 1, 1/2]

1665, Dec 11, William King security for estate of Thomas Darling (s/s Patuxent)

20,000lbs tob. (Test. Proc. 1F, 21-22, Admin. Bond)

1665/6 Jan 24, William King admin. of estate of Anthony Wilson (s.s.Patuxent) Letters issued to King as atty. of Ismael Wright, orig. admin. of the estate. (Test. Proc. 1F, 35-1/2-36, Power of Attorney)

1666 Sep 25 - William King of Calvert Co., tailor, assigned land to Ismael Wright.... [Patents 10, 169-70]

1666 Dec 20&31, Wm. Stockden to Wm. King - suit & pair silver buttons (Wills I, 277)

1667 Apr 12, William King petition re Geo. Colton late of Cal. Co. debt to petitioner of 1,000 lbs. tob. -- so ordered against Colton estate. [Arch. 57, p. 179; Prov. Ct. Jdmts.]

1674, Apr 9, William King & John Wingfield appraisers of Robt. Tyler Estate (Resurrection Manor) [Test. Proc. 6, 193-95, Will Proved, Admin. Granted]

1675 Nov 24, Marmaduke Semme vs. Wm King, Calvert Co. - Action re debt of 3,000 lbs tob for man servant which King had of Semme from 24 Feb 1673/4 and not paid.

King came not. Judgment for recovery to Semme against King 3,000 lbs tob & 526 lbs tob costs. [Arc. 65, p. 598; Prov. Ct.]

1674 Apr. 16, Richard Bayley vs. William King late of Calvert Co. - re cattle King took Dec 14, 1673 at Back Creek at Harvey Town - 2 cows, 2 calves, 2 heiffers & 1 bull. King shows he purchased the cattle from Mathew Smith on Oct 5, 1673 with sealed bond and afterwards on Nov 25, 1673 confirm with bill of sale. Judgment: King recover from Bayley tob for his costs and charges. [Arch. 65, p.239; Prov. Ct.]

1676 Sep 29 & Nov 21 - re Children of William King; Testator Guy White to children of William King - mare, foal, cow, calf, and their increase. [Wills V. 101]

1676 Sep 29 - William King, /s/Will/Guy White of Calvert - s.s. Patuxent. [Wills V, 101]

1676 Nov 2 - Will of Guy White proved by wit. John Halls & William King - both to appraise. [Test. Proc. 8, 282 Admin. Granted; Will Proved]

1676 Dec 1, judgement for William King of 28,763 lbs tob plus 1480 lbs tob for costs from also John Cramer of Calvert Co. satisfaction of judgement obtained fro 4,587lbs tob and 1480 lbs tob for costs. [Arch 66, p. 316, Prov. Ct. Jdmts. Bond of Admin. Assigned]

1679 Nov 29 - William King & John Pearce appraisers of estate for William Willson (s.s. Pat.) [Test. Proc. 11, 262; Admin. Granted]

1684 Nov 10/Jul 23, 1685 - Wm King /s/Will/Thoas Bankes/Calvert Co. [Wills IV, 126]

1688 July 16 - John Griggs returned. John Evans & Hugh Hopewell apprs. Richard Keene & John Nuthall securities. - 50,000lb tob [Test. Proc. 14, 82; Bond Returned]

1720 March 25, "Deptford" - Jno. Pollard to Charles King, tract so. sd. Patuxent River joining George Beckwith's Manor through Pollard's attorney, Richard Hopewell, SMC. [PCD, PL#5, 114-16] (Archives of MD Online, Vol. 721, Pg. 115 - John Pollard of Dor. Co. notes that Charles King is his well beloved friend)

1727 May 27, Ejectments, Box 44; Nuthalls lessee v. Biscoe - In 1726, James Riscoe of SMC, planter was attached to answer Charles King of a plea of forcible entry into Cross Manor, which Brent Nuthall demised to King. Biscoe takes defence for 200 ac. in the Cross Manor. Declaration sent to tenants John, Jane and James Briscoe.

1711 - Widow, Margaret King owned 150 acres, "Wright" at her death
