Sep 2, 1707 - heirs: wife, Alice; son, William; daughters Margaret Flake, Elizabeth Hill, Marion Chips, grandson Thomas Flake, son Robert Flake, Rec.Bk. 1694-1708, p. 374; marr. **Alice Warren** (dau. Capt. Thomas Warren, Sr., Esq. & Mary Alice Powell; Alice Marriot made depo Sep 15, 1677 stating her age as 32+) [See Warren Family](#) ; ISSUE:

### Marriot Research Log

**1673** July 23 - Mathias & Alice Marriot sell 400 acs. on Gray's Creek ("Smith's Fort" formerly in possession of Thomas Warren & adj. to William Marriot's land on so. sd. James River) to John Salway. [Record Book 1671-84, p. 30] - Note: This was deed to present day "Warren House" that was conveyed to Mathias Marriot under prenuptial agreement after his wife, Alice, inherited it when her brother William Warren died in 1670.

**1755** Sep 16 - **Mathias Marriot**, extr. brother Wm's estate, w/Benjamin Marriot [Surry Co. WD]

**1755** Nov 6 - **Mat. Marriot** - Inven. Wm's estate [Surry Co. WD]

**1759** Mar 20/Apr 17 - **Mathias Marriot** re suit agst. Benj. Taylor (farmer) [Surry Co. OB]

**1760** May 20 - **Mathias Marriot** re problem with road [Surry Co. OB]

**1763** Dec 22 - **Mathias Marriot** 800 acs., at head of Grey's Ck [Surry Co. DB]

**1765** Jun 18 - **Mathias Marriot** appointed overseer of the road. [Surry Co. OB]

**1766** Jun 16&21, Sep 15 - Mathias Marriot suit agst. Jno. Ormeston [York Co. OB]

**1766** Oct. 20 - **Mathias Marriot** bond re attachments to Jno. Ormeston Estate [York Co. OB]

**1767** Jan 20 - **Mathias Marriot**, Extr. rec'd land from father Wm Marriot's Will [Surry Co. WD]

**1767** Aug 15 - **Mathias Marriot** re Wm Marriot Estate & Merchant House of Shepard & Cooper in Barbados & amount due to Benjamin Powell [Surry Co. WD]

**1768** Mar 24 - **Mathias Marriot** suit agst. Fleming Bates, Quaker Tutor [York Co. OB]

**1769** Jun 20 - **Mathias Marriot** suit agst. Richard (?) [Surry Co. OB]

**1773** Apr - **Mathias Marriot** provided plank to Philip Moody [Webb-Prentis Papers 1757-1780]

**1774** Apr 27 - **Mathias Marriot** suit agst. Adam Cornwell [Surry Co. OB]

**1774** Oct 25 - **Mathias Marriot** Will is recorded re sawmill, boat, oxen, wheels, chains, carpenter & cooper tools; heirs: wife, Elizabeth; sons Wm & Thos; dau Sarah (Sally)

**1775** Aug 22 - **Marriott Estate** re Eliz., guardian for Thos, Wm. & Sarah Marriot [Surry Co. CO]

**1775** Sep 26 - **Mathias Marriot** re laborer hired for Bland's Road [Surry Co. CO]

**1777** Sep 26 & Aug 23/26 - **Mathias Marriot Estate** audited & settled [Surry Co. CO]

**1779** Aug 24 - Wm. & Thos Marriot chose Jacob Faulcon as guardian [Surry Co. CO]

**1782** Mar-May - VA Public Claims (Surry Co.)

- **Elizabeth Marriot** - 30 lbs. beef, 22 gallons brandy and cask, 325 lbs. beef, freighting 6749 lbs. bacon and 80 lbs. pork to College Landing, freighting 15531 lbs. bacon from

Cabin Point to College Landing, £9.10 for damages sustained in corn, pea and potato fields by a regiment of Brunswick County Militia under the command of Col. Richard Elliott during September and October 1781

- **Thomas Marriott** - 578 feet of plank

**1782** Oct 23 - **Wm & Thos Marriott** (Jacob Faulcon Guardian) and Carter & Sarah (Marriott)

Crafford sued **Elizabeth Marriott** for a change in distribution of father's slaves. [Surry Co. CO.]

**1783** Nov 25 - **Eliz. & Wm. Marriott** & guardian of **Thos. Marriott** sue Jno Logan [Surry Co. CO]

**1784** May 26 - **Eliz. Marriott** sued Nicholas Faulcon & **Wm. Marriott** [Surry Co. CO]

**1784** Jun 23, **Thos Marriott**, wife Nancy (Cocke) sued Thos./Susanna Cocke's Estate [Surry Co]

**1784** Oct 27 - **Thos Marriott** agst. John Logan & Wm. Proce [Surry Co. CO]

**1785** Mar 23 - **Eliz. Marriott's** suit agst. Jno .Logan dismissed [Surry Co. CO]

**1785** May 25 - **Thomas Merriott** agst. Samuel Smith [Surry Co. CO]

**1785** Dec 28 - Precinct 31 at "**Thomas Marriott's Mill**" on Weir Neck [Surry Co. Co]

**1794** Dec 3 - **Thos. Marriott** (dec'd) Estate Inventory: crosscut saw, old whip saws, iron chains, iron wedges, walnut plank, pair log wheels, ox carts, wheels, axes, & canoe.
