Hugh de Keveliock, Earl of Chester); **ISSUE:** 1. John 2. Leuca

1) Leuca, wife of Philip de Orreby, **daughter & finally sole representative of Roger de Montalt**, but Robert de Montalt, grandson of the said Roger and last baron of Montalt, by fine 1 Edw. p.102 - "De Montalt" of Chester, Palatine & Hawarden & shows arms & pedigree...per Dugdale's Genealogy

p. 103 - In 5 Henry II, a Pipe Roll had entry of Norfolk & suffolk as land of Earl of Chester..... **Robert de Montalt** also farmed the same in 6 & 7 Henry II; Robert de Montalt, solely, in 8 Henry II.....In Rolls of Norman Exchequer (1198 M. 15) grants are cited of land in Normandy made to **Robert de Montalt**, et al. The land of Montalt was at Le Tourneur, near Bayeus (Vol. 11, p. ccxiv).

p. 104 - This **Robert de Montalt** was called the "Black Steward of Chester", & **married Leuchas**, named in the Inquisition 4 Edw. 1, respecting the dowry of the successive Ladies of Hawarden, & also in **Ralph de Montalt's** grant of Neston to Chester Abbey for the souls of **Robert his father & Leuca his mother**.
