

DESCENDANTS OF JOHN NEWTON

Generation No. 1

Thomas NEWTON He was born Abt. 1614 in prob. Kingston-Upon-, Hull, Yorkshire, England. He died Abt. 1680 in prob. Kingston On Hull, Yorkshire, England. He is named as father of John Newton (eldest son) in depositions taken from the wife, son & daughter of John Newton after his death. However, mother & siblings of John are unknown.

Generation 2

John NEWTON, SR., b. abt. 1639 in prob. Kingston-on-hull, Yorkshire, England; d. on Jul 28, 1697 in , Westmoreland, VA. [1695 Will of John Newton named: wife, sons John, Joseph, Benjamin, Garrat, Thomas; daughter Elizabeth] [1709 July 8, MADAM ROSE NEWTON Deposition – “aged 80 yrs. or thereabouts” stated that John (her dec’d husband) is called “Master and Mariner” and speaks of John Newton as “Late of Kingstone upon Hull”.] 1st Wife (unknown) ISSUE:

i. John NEWTON JR, b. Abt. 1660 in prob. Camblesfort or Carlton, England; marr. Mary Allerton, daughter of Col. Isaac Allerton & Elizabeth Willoughby.

2nd Wife (unknown) ISSUE:

ii. Joseph NEWTON, b. Abt. 1664 in prob. Camblesfort or Carlton, England; marr. Sarah Butler, widow, abt. 1684.

3RD Wife, Elizabeth Laycoke (widow)

iii. Benjamin NEWTON, b. abt. 1669 in prob. Anlaby, England; marr. Mary.

4th Wife, Rose Tucker Gerrard (twice widowed), b. abt. 1629, VA; d. aft. Dec 01, 1712 Westmoreland Co., VA. Rose and John Newton m. May 16, 1677. Rose was widow of John Tucker (Will proved May 31, 1671 in Westmoreland Co., VA named daughters. Sarah & Rose (Fitzhugh Bible: Sarah b. 2 Aug 1663. Sarah marr. Wm Fitzhugh & Rose marr. Ebenezer Blackiston. (John F. Dorman, Westmoreland Deeds, Patents, etc., 1665-77), an eldest son unnamed, an unborn child (Gerrard), & wife, Rose. Rose was also widow of Thomas Gerrard (of Westmoreland Co., VA) who made a deed of gift to 4 children, specifying that they were children of John Tucker born of Dr. Gerrard's "now wife" Rose. The 1712 Will of Rose Newton (proved January 28, 1712 in Westmoreland Co., VA) bequeathed all her lands in VA, MD & lands of husband Thomas Gerrard to her son, Thomas. Thomas was only child named in his mother's Will. [VA Mag of Hist. & Bio, V. 1, July 1893, pg. 269]

iv. Gerrard (Tucker) NEWTON, b. abt. 1671/72 Westmoreland Co., VA; d. abt. 1726, VA; marr Rebecca.

v. Thomas NEWTON, b. abt. 1679 in prob. Westmoreland Co., VA; marr. Elizabeth Storke abt. 1698.

vi. ELIZABETH NEWTON , b. abt. 1675 in Westmoreland, VA; marr Benjamin BERRYMAN abt. 1700 in , Westmoreland, VA; d. bef. Feb 22, 1763, prob. Westmoreland Co, VA.

NOTE: 1709, July 8, **BENJAMIN NEWTON DEPOSITION:** He stated his age as, 40, and that John Newton, the elder, his father, lived at a place called Anlaby, near Hull (hence Benjamin was born abt. 1669, making Elizabeth Laycocke his mother & she the 3rd wife of John stated that his father, John Newton, emigrated to the colonies after the death of his last [English] wife.) Further that he [deponent] knew Thomas Newton who lived in Hull who always owned and acknowledged the said John Newton the elder this deponent’s father to be his lawful and eldest [son] and this deponent lastly saith that he came from the said Thomas Newton’s his grandfather when he came to Virginia.
