

DESCENDANTS OF JAMES NIPPER

James Nipper b. abt 1640, Northumberland, Co., Va.; marr. Jane (Morris?) b. abt 1640; d 1700, Northumberland, Co., VA. ISSUE:

1. **James Nipper II.**
2. **Isabell Nipper** abt. 1663. Isabell was given a heifer by Richard Spann on 8 Sep 1668; marr. John Crawford; d. bef. May 18, 1694
3. **John Nipper I** abt. 1664
4. Unk. **Nipper** abt 1665
5. **Mary Nipper** marr. Graves or Prichard
6. Unk. (**Katherine?**) b. abt. 1672; marr. John Francis Adams ([See Adams Tree](#))

Record Books, Northumberland Co., VA

- 1668 Sep 8 James Nipper** gave heifer to daughter Isabell (16.55)
1669 Jan 21, James Nipper gave bill of sale to William Alexander.
1670 Oct 1670, James Nipper rec'd land, Northumberland Co. from John Haymie & Jane Morris, his wife.
1672 April 17, James Nipper gives a heifer to his son, James.
1675 Jan 19, 1675, James Nipper's servant Neals Dorhorty, adjudged to be 15 yrs old.
1677 April 14, James Nipper, Fairfield Parish, buys land from Richard Smith on the Chicacoan River.
1678 Aug 21 - James Nipper & John Haymie proved last will of Hannah Bridgman by their oaths.
1679 June 7, James Nipper is shown on the list of Tythables (taxaes).
1679 Oct 15, James Nipper & Adam Garrett were surveyors until this date
- 1683 Dec 6, James Nipper** witnessed a deed from Hobbs to Crawford.
1687 July 2, James Nipper to teach William Odohorty, age 7, bound to him, to read
1694 Jan 16, James Nipper petitioned for a Probate of the will of John Crawford, deceased.
1694 May 18 1694, James Nipper, grandfather of John Crawford, orphaned son of John Crawford, dec'd, consents to him being bound by John Trimlett.
1694 June 20, James Nipper sold John Crawford's estate at outcry (auction).
1694 Nov 29 - James Nipper, 100ac, Northumberland Co., so. sd. Great Wiccocomico [Grants #2, p.86]
1695 James Nipper quit rents 100 acres of land.
- (All of the above events were taken from Books 1, 2, and 3, Records of Northumberland Co., on file in the Co. Court House, Heathsville, VA.)
- 1696 May 21 - Jane Nipper, Widow and Relict of James Nipper**, dec'd, granted Admin. of Estate.
1700 April 17-James Nipper, son of James, Executor, petitioned and was granted a Probate to him of the Last Will of Jane Nipper, deceased. The will was proved by the oaths of John Farnofold and for Codicil by Richard Smith.
