NOTES:

- 1) "Pearson's Island", Alexandria, VA (now Daingerfield Island) In 1669 John Alexander purchased part of the island. He gave 6,000-acre patent to son, Robert, who leased the entire island to Thomas Pearson III in 1696. The land owned by Alexander children & Thomas Pearson III came to figure in the estates of Geo. & Martha Washington families. Robert Alexander's son, John, married Pearson's granddaughter, George Washington's cousin. [http://alexandriava.gov/historic/archaeology/default.aspx?id=39120]
- 2) Robert Alexander in his 1735 Will devised "**Pearson's Island** where he now lives" to son John. His daughters Parthenia Massey & **Sarah Alexander rec'd 400 acs each**. He left Holmes Island (302 acres) & 1125 adjoining acs to son Gerrard.
