

DESCENDANTS OF ROBERT DE SHERBURNE

Generation 1

Robert de Sherburne, Stonyhurst (Lancashire-Yorkshire) (grandson of Geoffroy l'Arbalastier); marr. **Matilda**, sister of Adam de Catford, son of Adam Catford, son of Swanius of Carlton Magna, or Pulton in Lancashire (Stow MS); d. ca. 1260/61 (W., ii. 475) ISSUE: 1. John 2. William

1246 Oct 24 - **Robert de S.** present & cognisant "between Eve relict Galf. Balystar... (Feet of Fines, Lanc., Henry III #104)

1246 (ca.) John, Earl of Morton, afterwards King, gave 600 acs. in Haconsal & Presalto Geoffrey l'Arbalastier & **Robert de S.**, whose place of origin unk., rec'd as a gift from Geoffroy the Manor of Hameldon. According to Stow MS the Geoffroy (Rot. Oblat., 3 John, ps.1,m.2) who rec'd lands from the Earl of Morton was the father of another Geoffroy who is described as "Galfridus Balastarius of Manor of Hamelton & that **Robert de S.** was a son of the 2nd Geoffroy's brother John by his wife Anabilla.

Generation 2

John de Sherburne (son of Robert de S. & Matilda de Catford); marr. **Eva de Carlton**, dau. Walter de Carlton; ISSUE: 1. Robert

1262 Feb 16- **John de Sherburne** by fine made at Lancaster held with his heirs 460 acs in Hamiltone from Will of f. Rob. de Shyreburne" & his heirs forever, paying yearly one penny at Easter. John paying William (his brother per Stow MS) (Feet of Fines, Lanc., #174)

Robert de Sherburne, Chivaler, marr., **Alicia de Blackburne** (dau. & coheiress of John de Blackburne of Wiswall by Margaret, sister of Robert de Holand) ; ISSUE:

1. **Catherine** 2. Robert 3. Roger 4. Henry 5. Sir John deSherburne, M.P.O., Knight 6.Wm.
1278 - **Robert de S.** was Seneschal of Clitheroe (Stow MS) [Seneschal = officer in houses of nobles in middle ages per wikipedia]

1281 - **Robert de S.** was Seneschal of Blackburnshire (Stow MS)

1292 - July - **Robert de S.** was at Lancaster Assizes as Prior of Church of St. Mary of Lancaster sued Joh. f. Rob. de S. (John son fo Rob. de S.) for messuage & 240 acs. in Hameltone into which John entered only by demise, which Will. Duree, formerly Prior,predecessor of sd. Prior made to Rob. de S. for term that has expired. Joh. f. Rob. (John son of Robert) came & said that he is called Rob. f. Joh. (Robert son of John) not Joh. f. Rob. The Prior was fined for a false claim, but the fine was pardoned (Assize Rolls, Lanc., M. 3, 2-3, m. 63, dorso; W.)

1294 - Robert knighted, but excused by special favor from taking up knighthood 'til 1326 (Parl. Writs, Rc. Comm. 1827)

1294 - **Robert de S.** a wit. to grant of Chapel of St. Michael, Cliteroe Castle etc. (Great Coucher of Duchy of Lanc.i. 60; W.)

1303 June 25 - **Robert de S.** quitclaimed rights to Joan, wife of Thos. Banastre, Manor Little Singleton; messuages & lands in Thornton, Broughton, Dillworth, & Billesburgh (Final Concords, Lane, LCR 39, 207, #142)

1305-06 - **Robert de S.** was Seneschal of Blackburnshire (W., ii.268)

1306 Jan 27- **Robert de S.** quitclaimed right in messuage & 4 acs in Wythenhull & 2 pts. Manor of Gosenargh, & 1/6 pt. Manor Whytingham...(Final Concords, Lanc.; LCR #142)

1309 - **Robert de S.** was Seneschal of Longton (Stow MS)

1311 - **Robert de S.** held pt. of 200 acs. in Wiswall by 4th pt. knight's fee (W1, ii.29)

1312 - **Robert de S.** was Seneschal of Blackburnshire (Stow MS)

1313 - **Robert de S.**, Commissioner oyer & Terminer (*meaning criminal court*) re appeal in co. Lanc. (C.P.R., 542)

1313 Oct - **Robert de S.** was an adherent of Thomas, Earl of Lancaster who rec'd pardon for participation in death of Peter de Gaveston & disturbances (C.P.R. Rymer's Foedera)
1313 - **Robert de S.** rec'd pardon for acquiring land in Penryns (C.P.R. 595)
1313 - **Robert de S.** was Vice Justice of co. Lanc.
1318 - **Robert de S.** was conservator of peace in co. Lanc. (Parl. Writs, Rec. Comm.)
1319-20 - **Robert de S.** a recognisant to the Abbot of Chester (Recog.Rolls, Chester)
1325 April 13 - **Robert de S.** at Preston Assizes (Assize Rolls, Lanc., M.3,3-12J(17), m.4; W).
1328 - **Robert de S.** was **Vice-Justice** of co. Chester (Chester Chamberlain's Accts.)
1328 - Robert de S. appointed to take an inquest on de la March (Index Rolls Parl.)
1328 - **Robert de S.** one of commission of oyer & terminer at Whalley (C.P.R.)
1328 - **Robert de S.** in custody of Abbey of Combermere, co. Chester, owing to its bad govt.
1328 - **Alicia** was exor (wife) of **Rob. de Shirburne, Chevalier**
1329 Nov 18 - **Robert de S.** & wife, Alicia rec'd message & 6 acs. one rood of land in Longton & Hogwyk (Feet of Fines, Lanc., Edward III., No. 16; W.).
1331& 1333 - **Robert de S.** one of commission of oyer & terminer at Whalley (C.P.R.)
1331 Oct 25 - **Robert de S.**, et al inquiry of Richard de Spaldyngton (C.C.R. 355)
1332 - **Robert de S.** appointed to see ships in ports of Chester & Flint co. (C.P.R., 323)
1332 - **Robert de S.**, et al appointed to choose 400 archers & 100 hoblers in co. Lanc. to with the King for defence of marches of Scotland (C.P.R. 359)
1333 - **Robert de S.** appointed Commissioner for letting forfeited estates in Yorkshire (Manor of Halghton) (Index Rollls Parl., #814)
1333 - **Robert de S.** was a collector of 15th & 10ths in Lancashire (C.C.R. 61)
1333 (winter) - **Robert de S.** wit. quit-claim at Reued
1334 - **Robert de S.** with his wife granted 1/4 pt. Manor of Aighton to Robert, their son (Cuerdon MS, iii, EColl. Arms; W.)
1334 - **Robert de S.** and wife Alice granted land at Pub. Rec. Off. (Lanc., B 2945)
1334 - **Robert de S.** paid arrears & robes past due by order to Treasurer of Exchequer as **Robert de S.** was retained of King's Council while he was Earl of Chester (CCR 266-69)
1335 Jan 28 & Mar 27 - **Robert de S.** to furnish men with arms in co. Lancaster (C.P.R.)
1335 May 26 - **Robert de S.** sat in Parliament at York (Index to M.P.)
1335 June 20 - **Robert de S.** appointed as a taxer in co. Lancaster (CCR 504/515)
1335 July 26 - **Robert de S.** 2nd time appointed to keep King's peace in co. Lancaster (C.P.R. 201)

Richard "de Bayley" Sherburne, Esq., b. Oct 12, 1381, Stonyhurst, Cliteroe, Lancaster, Eng.; d. May 25, 1441 same place & buried in Church at Mitton, Lancaster, Eng.; marr. **Agnes Harrington** (dau. Nicholas Harington & Isabel English) (See [Harrington Family](#)); ISSUE:

1. Alice 2.Richard 3.Robert 4.Isabel 5.John 6.Nicholas 7.Elizabeth 8.James 9.Mabel

a) **1437 Will of Richard Sherburne** cited wife, Agnes, Robert of Haryngton, Knight, Thomas of Harington, Squyer, brother of ye same Robert... also made bequest to parish church of Mitton & to religious orders; [*Testamenta Eboracensia, Part II, 75-76, vol. 30 (1855), Publications of the Surtees Society.*]

b) **1444 Nov 3 Will of Agnes Sherburne** mentions Dame Elizabeth Staneley, sister; living children, son Richard; Dame Alice Tempest, Robert, Isabel, Elizabeth, John, Nicholas, John & Mabel; also Thomas Staneley, Knight; Thomas Haryngton, Esqwier....[*Testamenta Eboracensia, Part II, at 105-106.*]

Generation 9

Alice Sherburne, b. ca. 1400 Stonyhurst, Cliteroe, Lancaster, Eng.; d. ca. 1420 Bracewell, West Riding, Yorkshire, Eng.; marr. **Sir John Tempest**, High Sheriff of Yorkshire, Knight (son of Sir Piers Tempest, Knight & Dorothy Hebden. [See Tempest Family](#)).
