Co., 365 acs, being the remaining undevise part of a tract of land called "**Jourdan**", formerly the estate and property of sd John Smith, decd, father to sd John, party to these presents, and part of which sd tract called Jourdan the sd John Smith, decd, did, by his will, devise as follows, to wit...200 acs to his daughter Precilla,...300 acs to his daughter Elizabeth,300 acs to his daughter Sarah, ...300 acres to sd John Smith, party to these presents. The part being conveyed herein lies between Elizabeth's part and Sarah's part, and is the right of sd John, party to these presents, as heir at law of sd John Smith, decd, his father, /s/ - John Smith.
