

**James R. Turner (J. R. Turner), Private/Corporal, Co. A, 24 Battalion, TN Sharp Shooters (Confederate)**

Also known as Maney's Battalion – it became part of 1 Consolidated Reg't TN, Infantry, about April 9, 1865. J. R. Turner enlisted Sep. 7, 1861 at Waverly, TN by Col. Scudder to Aug. 31, 1862.

**1862: Prisoner of War** sent to Camp Morton, Ind., to Vicksburg, Miss. to be exchanged – Roll dated Aug. 28, 1862. Captured at Fort Donelson, Feb. 16, 1862. Declared exchanged at Aikens Landing, Nov. 10, 1862.

**1861-1863:** Present Sep. 1861 to Feb. 28, 1863 J. R. Turner, Private, Lt. Artillery, TN Volunteers under Capt. Frank Maney's Co. Appears on muster roll

**1863:** Present March/April 1863; J. R. Turner, Private, Lt. Artillery, TN Volunteers under Capt. Frank Maney's Co.; last paid by Capt. Dashell to Feb 28, 1863.

**1863:** Present July/Aug 1863; J. R. Turner, Corporal, Capt. H. M. McAdoo's Co. Lt. Artillery; Last paid by Capt. Pilcher to July 1, 1863.

**1863:** Present Sep/Oct 1863; J. R. Turner, Corporal, Capt. H. M. McAdoo's Co. Lt. Artillery; last paid by Capt. Pilcher to Sep 1863.

**1863:** Present Nov/Dec 186; J. R. Turner, Private, Lt. Artillery, TN Volunteers under Capt. Frank Maney's Co.; last paid by Capt. Camp to Nov 1, 1863.

**1864:** Present Jan/Feb 1864; J. R. Turner, Private, Lt. Artillery, TN Volunteers under Capt. Frank Maney's Co.; last paid by Capt. Pilcher to Jan 1, 1864.

**1864:** March/April 1864 - **Absent on furlough** ; J. R. Turner, Private, Lt. Artillery, TN Volunteers under Capt. Frank Maney's Co.
